The trail is nearly all along the river with very little road hiking. It's a pretty rough trail. I would suggest hiking in cooler weather, such as mid-fall.

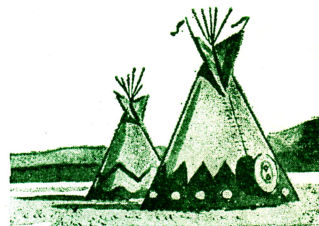

# *Amaquonsippi Trail Camp*

To Qualify for the Amaquonsippi Trail Camp Award:



1. Do not ditch tents.
2. All paper is to be burned.
3. All garbage is to be dried and then burned.  
DO NOT put garbage in barrels.
4. Tin cans are to be burned out, flattened, and placed in appropriate container.
5. Glass jars and bottles are to be washed and placed in containers with cans. DO NOT break glass.
6. Fires are to be in designated places, never left unwatched, and are to be extinguished before leaving area.
7. Replace fire wood used during your stay.
8. Police area thoroughly before leaving.
9. Cars are to be parked in the parking lot.

We do not like a lot of rules any better than you do, but by abiding by these camping rules the area will remain suitable for camping for the Scouts yet to visit us.

One camp patch will be awarded, free of charge, to every registered hiker for Units qualifying.

The campsite inspection will be made just prior to your departure.
