Amaquonsippi Trail Camp

To Qualify for the Amaquonsippi Trail Camp Award:



1. Do not ditch tents.
2. All paper is to be burned. All garbage is to be dried and then burned, DO NOT put garbage in barrels. DO NOT bury garbage.
3. Tin cans are to be burned out, flattened, and placed in appropriate container. Glass jars and bottles are to be washed and placed in containers with cans. DO NOT break glass.
4. All Scouts must have qualified supervision at all times. No Scout is to leave Trail Camp unless accompanied by an adult.
5. Do not wash dishes or your person at the well—Wash in your campsite.
6. Fires are to be in designated places, never left unwatched, and are to be extinguished before leaving area.
7. Do not use firewood in wood shelter unless all other wood is wet. Replace fire wood used during your stay.
8. Police area thoroughly before leaving.
9. Cars are to be parked in the parking lot.
10. CAMP GOOD TURN. This is to be one hour work by each hiker. The work to be done will be designated by Camp Ranger.

We do not like a lot of rules any better than you do, but by abiding by these camping rules the area will remain suitable for camping for the Hikers yet to visit us.

One camp patch will be awarded, free of charge, to every registered hiker who pays the \$3.25 fee for Units qualifying.

The campsite inspection will be made just prior to your departure.
